- Assist staff and volunteers with project management and some general office duties.

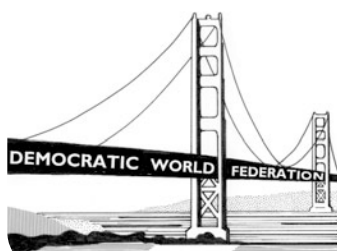
In return, you will:
